## 40 DAYS OF COMMUNITY?

*40 Days of Community* is an effort to build the sense of community in our area, and in our church. This campaign is going to change all of our lives because this is the one time we align everything from children, youth, and adults to focus on spiritually deepening our church and ourselves. Small groups will be meeting in homes once a week for six weeks where we will focus on deepening relationships and serving our communities. In this campaign we're going to answer the question "**What on earth are WE here for?**" and look at how God's purposes relate to our church and our local community.

In order to get the most out of this campaign, you need to be in a small group! We are asking everyone in our church to participate in the following ways:

1. Join or host a *40 Days of Community* small group. Your group will meet once a week for six weeks. This can be a current small group or a completely new one.
2. Attend a Sunday morning service every week during the campaign.
3. Read the 40 daily devotionals based on the "one another" passages found in the Bible.
4. Use the memory verse tags that will be distributed. Each of the six weeks includes one verse that we will memorize together as a church.
5. Work together on a community mission project.

*40 Days of Community* is a step of faith we've taken as a church and because you're involved you're going to grow too! By getting into a small group you're not only going to experience all the campaign has to offer, you're going to make some friends. And we can't wait to hear the stories of how God has changed your life and the lives of others in our small groups!

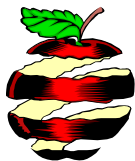

## FAITH CIRCLE

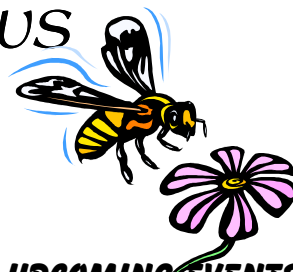

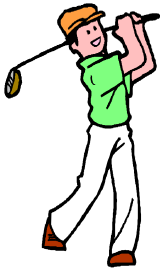

# Sunday School NEWS

## Elementary Sunday School

Kids K-6<sup>th</sup> grades will learn a new virtue each month with 252 Basics. This curriculum concentrates on:

- 1) I need to make the wise choice.
- 2) I can trust God no matter what.
- 3) I need to treat others the way I want to be treated.

Beginning in September, we will concentrate on Responsibility, followed by Individuality in October. Each month our kids will be empowered to live out these Christian virtues through Bible lessons, group discussion, music, skits, games, and more. On September 10<sup>th</sup>, our elementary curriculum and our topics of study for Route 252 will coordinate each week to emphasize the point of the day and send our kids home with a solid Bible lesson and ideas to think about over the week.

## Preschool Sunday School

This fall, starting September 10<sup>th</sup>, our preschool Sunday School will begin a new curriculum. Our preschoolers (2-5 years old) will use First Look which concentrates on three major concepts that our little ones need to know.

- 1) God made me.

- 3) Jesus wants to be my forever friend.

Each month the preschoolers will concentrate on one of these themes by learning four Bible lessons, along with songs, crafts, games, and more.
