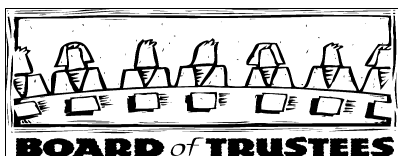
### He Sent His Word and Healed Them

We are seeing lives being changed as we continue to minister to the brokenhearted through our **Healing Hearts Bible Studies**.

**Binding Up the Brokenhearted** is an 11 week Bible study written specifically for women suffering from a past abortion. It's a safe place where they can openly share their pain with other women without fear of judgment or condemnation. The counselors have personally experienced abortion and have walked through the healing process. The next group begins February 1, 2007 at AAA Crisis Pregnancy Center in Livonia.

**The Hem of His Garment** is a new 10 week Bible study helping women overcome the hurts of the past, including abuse, unforgiveness, bitterness, anger, shame, guilt or painful secrets that they have kept for years. Its author uses her own personal testimony of suffering to help women understand that genuine hope and healing can only be found in Jesus. There is no hurt so great or wound so deep that the love of God can not touch. Our next group begins January 30, 2007 at AAA Pregnancy Center in Livonia.

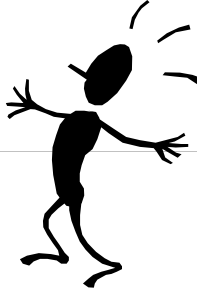
